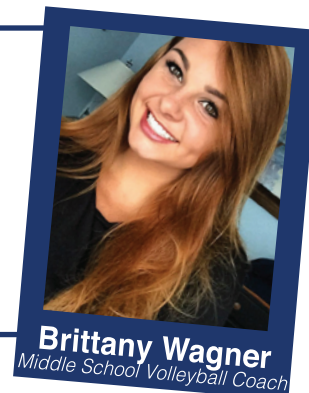
INTRODUCING...
