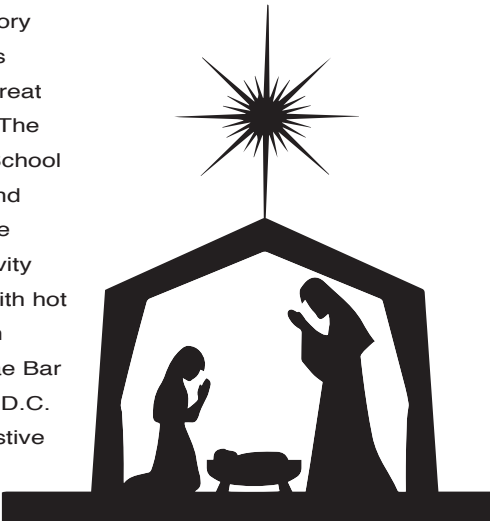

# Christmas Concert

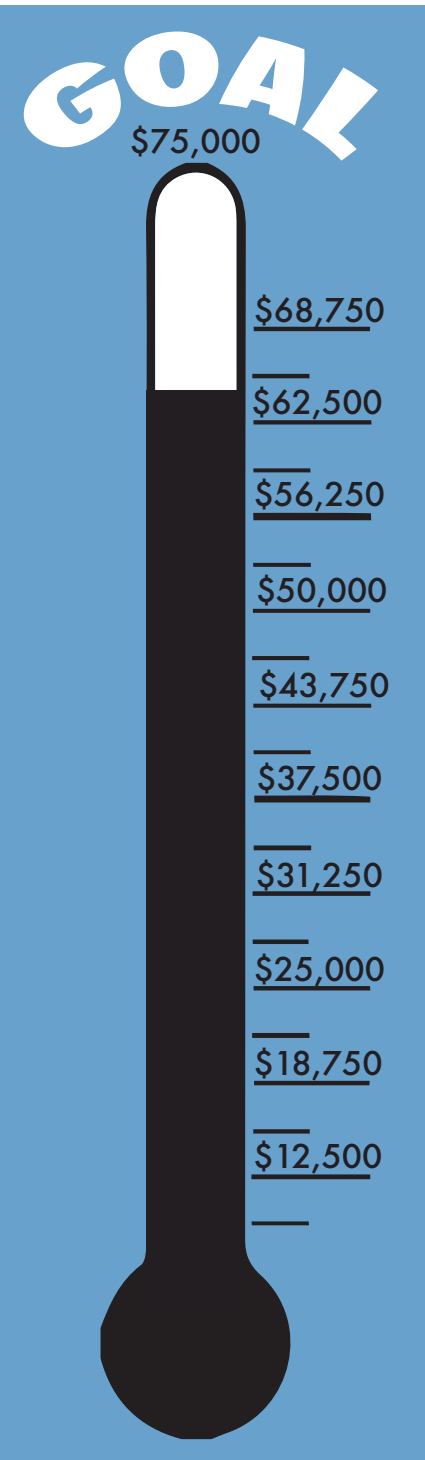
December 12 @ 6:30pm

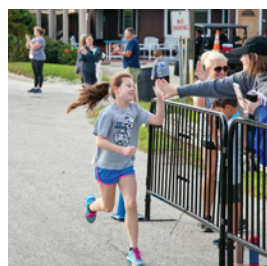
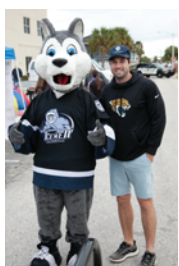
## See You at the Pole

Middle School Soccer had a great season reaching the fourth seed in the JCAL Tournament. Coach Becca looks forward to having most of the team return next season.

The Middle School Volleyball was the fourth seed in the JCAL Tournament out of ten teams. They are a young team who look forward to competing again next year.

Our Varsity Volleyball team won the FCAL North Championship and finished second overall in the tournament. Freshman, Victoria Papineau led the state in serving aces and serving ace percentage and was 30th in the nation. She was also the Runner-Up for the FCAL Player of the Year.

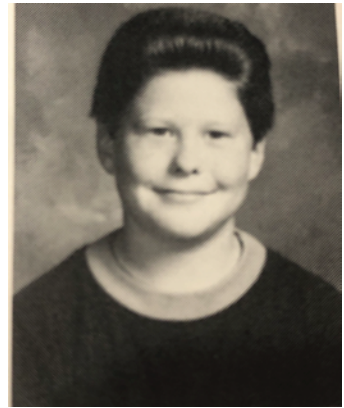
